VITAMIN

01

Last week, the vitamin market remained generally stable. K3 producers continued to raise prices, while low-priced supply in the market became increasingly limited. Downstream buyers mainly purchased on a hand-to-mouth basis.

AMINO ACID

02

- Last week, the amino acid market showed a weak trend overall, as pre-holiday restocking demand remained limited and trading activity was relatively quiet.
- Tryptophan prices are expected to remain stable in the short term, with mainstream transactions around USD 4.82/KG. Valine prices softened slightly, with deals mainly around USD 1.9/KG, and further downside pressure may emerge after the holiday. Supply of isoleucine remains tight, with some producers limiting sales, and prices are expected to stay stable in the near term.

API

03

- Last week, the veterinary API market remained stable but slightly weak overall. Most products stayed flat or softened slightly due to cautious demand and conservative purchasing behavior.
- Tylosin tartrate, tilmicosin phosphate, and doxycycline hydrochloride prices declined slightly, while florfenicol, amoxicillin, enrofloxacin, ciprofloxacin hydrochloride, and sulfonamide products remained firm under cost support. Oxytetracycline and lincomycin prices were generally stable.

FOOD ADDITIVE

04

- Last week, sucralose prices remained stable, with mainstream market transactions around USD 12.62-12.88/KG, though further increases remain possible.
- In the nutritional supplement segment, creatine monohydrate prices continued to show an upward trend, with current transaction prices stable at around USD 3.38-3.64/KG and delivery schedules extending to the end of May.
