According to market sources, as of October 22, Zhejiang Medicine Co., Ltd. has increased the price of feed-grade Vitamin E 50% to USD 5.61/kg and implemented a quota-based order policy. This adjustment, market attention has surged, and transaction prices have risen to around USD 5.11–5.23/kg. Some customers have yet to receive their goods or even be placed in the delivery queue. To secure supply, several downstream buyers have begun sourcing spot goods at USD 5.23–5.36/kg.

Market activity remains strong, driven by restocking demand and large-volume inquiries, while supply stays tight due to limited factory capacity. The upward trend in Vitamin E prices has become evident, and manufacturers' order policies will largely determine future movements. International buyers are advised to stay flexible—optimizing procurement timing, inventory, and sourcing strategies to ensure stable supply and cost efficiency amid volatility.

Recently, Isoleucine prices have remained stable, with market quotations ranging between USD 2.80–2.93/kg. Trading activity has been subdued, with weak demand and limited restocking from end users, resulting in slightly lower actual transaction prices. A narrow price adjustment is expected in the short term, and market participants are advised to closely monitor transaction trends.

Prices for Enrofloxacin and Ciprofloxacin HCl have remained near the bottom of their recent ranges. Current bulk transaction prices stand at approximately USD 20.32–20.94/kg for Enrofloxacin and USD 18.07–19.32/kg for Ciprofloxacin HCl. Market attention has slightly decreased compared with the first half of the year. Prices are expected to remain steady at low levels in the short term, though demand and quotations around the upcoming API exhibition warrant continued observation.
